
Enrolment for 2025/2026.

Thanks so much to those parents and students that are using the school pathways to enter the school grounds. We would also like to thank parents and students for making sure that gates are closed during school hours. We really appreciate your efforts to keep our students safe.

We have a few health and safety reminders that we would like to bring to your attention.

- There is no parking at the school. Parents will not be able to park at the top end of Old Bawn Avenue from the signage point. We are operating our *Safe Street* which means cars can drive up Old Bawn Avenue and drive down Tymon Crescent in a loop. Please be mindful of our neighbours on Old Bawn Ave, Tymon Crescent and other local roads at school drop off and collection times.
- Parents using the car park for drop off and pick up for after school activities are asked to reverse park and accompany children through the car park.
- Dogs are not allowed on school premises.
- We would encourage all parents to enter and exit the school grounds through the gate closest to the playground and not to use the gate by the car park.
- If you need to access the grounds during the school hours please ensure that the gates are left closed behind you.
- Wet Days: children should arrive at school at 8.50am and later. If they do get to school
 before that there are shelters by each door. As we all know the weather in Ireland is very
 changeable so we would encourage all children to have a raincoat in their bags or wear a
 coat each day.
